AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles, further
3 providing for short title of chapter, for definitions, for
4 restricted accounts, for registration of dealers, for
5 registration of snowmobile or ATV, for limited registration
6 of snowmobile or ATV, for certificate of title for snowmobile
7 or ATV, for transfer to or from dealer, for transfer of
8 snowmobile or ATV by operation of law, for issuance of new
9 certificate following transfer, for suspension and
10 cancellation of certificate of title, for application for
11 certificate of title by agent, for perfection of security
12 interest in a snowmobile or ATV, for satisfaction of security
13 interest, for release of security interest, for assignment by
14 secured party of security interest, for exemptions, for
15 snowmobile or ATV purchased from dealer, for fees, for
16 records, for Snowmobile and ATV Advisory Committee, for
17 operation on streets and highways, for designation of
18 snowmobile and ATV roads, for special snowmobile and ATV
19 events, for operation on private or State property, for
20 operation by persons under age sixteen, for operation in safe
21 manner, for additional limitations on operation, for
22 accidents and accident reports, for liability of owner for
23 negligence, for liability insurance, for head lamps and tail
24 lamps, for brakes, for mufflers and sound control, for
25 enforcement personnel and procedures and for penalties for
26 violation of chapter; and making editorial changes.

27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
28 hereby enacts as follows:

29 Section 1. The heading of Chapter 77 of Title 75 of the

1 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

2 CHAPTER 77

3 SNOWMOBILES [AND], ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND OFF-HIGHWAY
4 MOTORCYCLES

5 Section 2. Section 7701 of Title 75 is amended to read:

6 § 7701. Short title of chapter.

7 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the
8 Snowmobile [and], All-Terrain Vehicle and Off-Highway Motorcycle
9 Law.

10 Section 3. The definition of "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV"
11 in section 7702 of Title 75 is amended and the section is
12 amended by adding a definition to read:

13 § 7702. Definitions.

14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
15 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
16 meanings given to them in this section:

17 "All-terrain vehicle" or "ATV." A motorized off-highway
18 vehicle which travels on three or more off-highway tires and
19 which has:

20 (1) a maximum width of 50 inches and a maximum dry
21 weight of 1,200 pounds; or

22 (2) a width which exceeds 50 inches or a dry weight
23 which exceeds 1,200 pounds.

24 ATV's described in paragraph (1) may be referred to as Class I
25 ATV's, and ATV's described in paragraph (2) may be referred to
26 as Class II ATV's. This term does not include snowmobiles,
27 [trail bikes,] off-highway motorcycles, motorboats, golf carts,
28 aircraft, dune buggies, automobiles, construction machines,
29 trucks or home utility machines; military, fire, emergency and
30 law enforcement vehicles; implements of husbandry; multipurpose

1 agricultural vehicles; vehicles used by the department; or any
2 vehicle that is or is required to be registered under Chapter 13
3 (relating to registration of vehicles). In addition, this term
4 does not include off-road motor vehicles used exclusively as
5 utility vehicles for agricultural or business operations and
6 incidentally operated or moved upon the highway.

7 * * *

8 "Off-highway motorcycle" or "OHM." A motor vehicle used off
9 the roads or highways of this Commonwealth that has a seat or
10 saddle for the use of the rider and is designed to travel with
11 not more than two wheels in contact with the ground, including
12 dual sport motorcycles.

13 * * *

14 Section 4. Sections 7706(a)(1) and (2), (b), (c) and (e) and
15 7711(a) and (e) introductory paragraph, (3) and (4) of Title 75
16 are amended to read:

17 § 7706. Restricted accounts.

18 (a) Deposit and use of moneys.--

19 (1) The ATV and OHM Management Restricted Account and
20 the Snowmobile Management Restricted Account are established
21 in the State Treasury. The department shall deposit the
22 following into the appropriate restricted account:

23 (i) all moneys received from the registration of and
24 issuance of certificates of title for snowmobiles [and],
25 ATV's or OHM's and from the issuance of vintage
26 snowmobile permits;

27 (ii) all revenue from the sale of any publications
28 or services relating to snowmobiles [and],
29 ATV's and
OHM's;

30 (iii) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed

1 and collected as a result of enforcement activities
2 conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
3 under this chapter related to violations attributed to
4 ATV's and OHM's shall be deposited in the ATV and OHM
5 Management Restricted Account;

6 (iv) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed
7 and collected as a result of enforcement activities
8 conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
9 under this chapter related to violations attributed to
10 snowmobiles shall be deposited in the Snowmobile
11 Management Restricted Account; and

12 (v) all refunds of gas taxes generated under section
13 9017(d.1) (relating to refunds) shall be deposited in the
14 two restricted accounts on a proportional basis of the
15 activity that generated those taxes.

16 (2) The department shall draw moneys from the respective
17 restricted accounts for use in performing any activities
18 necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter,
19 including registration and certificate of title activities,
20 training, education, enforcement activities, construction and
21 maintenance of snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM trails and
22 acquisition of equipment, supplies and interests in land. All
23 moneys deposited in these accounts shall remain in them to be
24 used as specified in this section. With the exception of
25 trails used by [both] snowmobiles [and], ATV's and OHM's,
26 under no circumstances shall the department expend any moneys
27 from the accounts except for the activity that generated
28 those accounts.

29 * * *

30 (b) Grant-in-aid.--The department shall, upon written

1 application and subsequent approval, grant money from the
2 restricted accounts:

3 (1) To municipalities, profit and nonprofit
4 organizations in connection with snowmobile [and], ATV and
5 OHM use on lands [not owned by the Commonwealth] for the
6 following:

7 (i) Plans, specifications and engineering surveys.

8 (ii) Fees and costs related to the preparation or
9 performance of right-of-way lease agreements.

10 (iii) Land acquisition.

11 (iv) Construction, maintenance and rehabilitation of
12 trails and other facilities for snowmobiles [and], ATV's
13 and OHM's.

14 (2) To municipalities and profit and nonprofit
15 organizations for equipment, training and education
16 activities relating to snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM use.

17 (3) To profit and nonprofit organizations for the
18 maintenance, rehabilitation and construction of snowmobile
19 [and], ATV and OHM trails on land owned by the Commonwealth.

20 * * *

21 (c) Audit of moneys.--The restricted accounts shall be
22 audited every two years. Copies of the audit shall be provided
23 to the Snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM Advisory Committee, the
24 Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations
25 Committee of the House of Representatives. Copies shall also be
26 posted and maintained on the department's publicly accessible
27 Internet website.

28 * * *

29 (e) Definition.--For purposes of this section, "all-terrain
30 vehicle" or "ATV" shall also include any self-propelled vehicle

1 which is manufactured for sale or operation primarily on off-
2 highway trails or off-highway competition and only incidentally
3 operated on public highways. This term includes OHMs. This term
4 shall not include a snowmobile or other self-propelled vehicles
5 manufactured for off-highway use exclusively designed for travel
6 on snow or ice, steered by skis or runners and supported in
7 whole or in part by one or more skis, belts or cleats which
8 utilize an endless belt tread.

9 § 7711. Registration of dealers.

10 (a) General rule.--A person who is in the business of
11 selling snowmobiles [or], ATV's or OHM's in this Commonwealth
12 shall register with the department as a dealer. A person who is
13 in the business of selling snowmobiles [or], ATV's or OHM's
14 outside this Commonwealth may register with the department as a
15 dealer.

16 * * *

17 (e) Use of dealer registration plates.--A dealer may operate
18 or permit to be operated within this Commonwealth a snowmobile
19 [or], ATV or OHM owned by or in the possession of the dealer if:

20 * * *

21 (3) There is displayed on the snowmobile [or], ATV or
22 OHM in a manner prescribed by the department a valid dealer
23 registration plate issued to the dealer under this section.

24 (4) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is operated only for
25 the purpose of demonstration or testing in connection with
26 the dealer's business.

27 Section 5. Section 7711.1 heading, (a) introductory
28 paragraph, (1), (2) and (4), (b) introductory paragraph, (1) and
29 (2), (d) (2) and (f) (1), (2), (3) and (4) are amended and the
30 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

1 § 7711.1. Registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

2 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in
3 subsection (f), it is unlawful for a person to operate or for an
4 owner to permit another person to operate a snowmobile [or], an
5 ATV or an OHM unless:

6 (1) There is carried on the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM
7 a valid registration certificate issued therefor pursuant to
8 subsection (b).

9 (2) There is displayed on the snowmobile a registration
10 decal, or on the ATV or OHM a registration plate, issued
11 therefor pursuant to subsection (b).

12 * * *

13 (4) There is displayed on the snowmobile [or], ATV or
14 OHM a valid expiration sticker issued therefor pursuant to
15 subsection (b).

16 * * *

17 (b) Issuance.--Upon receipt of an application therefor upon
18 a form prescribed and furnished by the department which shall
19 contain information reasonably required by the department and
20 which shall be accompanied by the required fee, the department
21 shall issue to the owner of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM:

22 (1) A biennial registration certificate containing the
23 registration number for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and
24 the expiration date of the registration.

25 (2) A registration decal displaying the registration
26 number for a snowmobile or a registration plate displaying
27 the registration number for an ATV or OHM.

28 * * *

29 (c.1) Exception.--OHM's registered with the Department of
30 Transportation do not require a registration plate.

1 (d) Expiration of registration.--

2 * * *

3 (2) Upon transfer of ownership of a snowmobile [or], ATV
4 or OHM during a registration period, the registration
5 certificate and expiration sticker shall expire. The
6 transferor shall, within 15 days from the date of transfer,
7 return to the department the registration certificate with
8 the date of transfer and the name and address of the new
9 owner endorsed on the back. If the transferor applies for
10 registration of a different snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and
11 pays the required transfer fee, the transferor may be issued
12 in the name of the transferor a registration certificate and
13 expiration sticker for that snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for
14 the remainder of the registration period without payment of a
15 registration fee. The registration decal or plate shall not
16 be removed from a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM upon transfer
17 to the new owner and is invalid until the new owner is issued
18 a registration certificate or limited registration
19 certificate for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

20 * * *

21 (f) Exemptions from registration.--Subsection (a) does not
22 apply if:

23 (1) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is owned by or in
24 the possession of a dealer who has been issued a dealer
25 registration certificate, dealer registration plates and
26 dealer plate registration cards under section 7711 (relating
27 to registration of dealers), the dealer is in compliance with
28 section 7711 and the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is used in
29 accordance with section 7711.

30 (2) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is owned and used by

1 the United States or another state or a political subdivision
2 thereof, in which case the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM shall
3 display the name of the owner in a manner prescribed by the
4 department.

5 (3) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is operated on land
6 owned or leased by the owner or operator of the snowmobile
7 [or], ATV or OHM and it is not operated elsewhere within this
8 Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided in this
9 subsection, an OHM does not need to be registered with the
10 department when the OHM operator is invited on the land by
11 the owner or lessee of the land.

12 (4) The owner of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is not
13 a resident of this Commonwealth and the operator presents
14 proof that the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has been properly
15 registered in another jurisdiction that exempts from its
16 registration requirements persons who have obtained proper
17 registration under this chapter.

18 * * *

19 Section 6. Sections 7711.2 heading, (a) introductory
20 paragraph and (2), (b) and (d), 7712.1 heading, (a), (b), (c),
21 (d), (g), (h) (2) and (3) and (j), 7712.2(a), (b), (c)
22 introductory paragraph and (d), 7712.3 heading, (a) and (c),
23 7712.5(c), 7712.6(a) and (b), 7712.7(a) and (c), 7712.8 heading,
24 (a), (b) and (c), 7712.9(a) and (b), 7712.10, 7712.12(a) and
25 7712.13 of Title 75 are amended to read:

26 § 7711.2. Limited registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

27 (a) General rule.--It is unlawful for a person to operate or
28 for an owner to permit another person to operate a snowmobile
29 [or], ATV or OHM identified in section 7711.1(f) (3) (relating to
30 registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM) unless:

1 * * *

2 (2) There is displayed on the snowmobile a valid
3 registration decal or on the ATV or OHM a valid registration
4 plate issued pursuant to subsection (b).

5 * * *

6 (b) Issuance.--Upon receipt of an application therefor upon
7 a form prescribed and furnished by the department which shall
8 contain information reasonably required by the department, the
9 department shall issue to the owner of a snowmobile [or], ATV or
10 OHM for which limited registration is required under subsection
11 (a):

12 (1) A limited registration certificate containing the
13 registration number for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

14 (2) A registration decal displaying the registration
15 number for a snowmobile or a registration plate displaying
16 the registration number for an ATV or OHM.

17 * * *

18 (d) Transfer of ownership.--Upon transfer of ownership of a
19 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a limited registration
20 certificate has been issued, the limited registration
21 certificate shall become invalid. The transferor shall, within
22 15 days from the date of transfer, return to the department the
23 limited registration certificate with the date of transfer and
24 the name and address of the new owner endorsed on the back. The
25 registration decal or plate shall not be removed from the
26 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM upon transfer to the new owner and
27 is invalid until the new owner obtains a registration
28 certificate or limited registration certificate for the
29 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

30 * * *

1 § 7712.1. Certificate of title for snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

2 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in
3 subsection (b), an owner of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM which
4 is in this Commonwealth and for which no certificate of title
5 has been issued shall apply to the department for a certificate
6 of title.

7 (b) Exemptions from titling.--No certificate of title is
8 required for:

9 (1) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM that was registered
10 prior to the effective date of this section.

11 (2) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by the United
12 States unless a general registration certificate has been
13 issued therefor.

14 (3) A new snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a dealer
15 before and until sale.

16 (4) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a nonresident
17 of this Commonwealth and not required by law to be registered
18 in this Commonwealth.

19 (5) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a resident of
20 this Commonwealth and required by law to be registered in
21 another state, based and used principally outside of this
22 Commonwealth and not required by law to be registered in this
23 Commonwealth.

24 (6) A non-street legal OHM purchased after the enactment
25 of this subsection.

26 (c) Contents of application.--Application for a certificate
27 of title shall be made upon a form prescribed and furnished by
28 the department and shall contain a full description of the
29 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM, date of purchase, the name and
30 address of the owner, a statement of the title of applicant,

1 together with any other information or documents the department
2 requires to identify the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and to
3 enable the department to determine whether the owner is entitled
4 to a certificate of title.

5 (d) Signing and filing of application.--Application for a
6 certificate of title shall be made within 15 days of the sale or
7 transfer of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM or its entry into this
8 Commonwealth from another jurisdiction, whichever is later. The
9 application shall be accompanied by the required fee and any tax
10 payable by the applicant under the laws of this Commonwealth in
11 connection with the acquisition or use of a snowmobile [or], ATV
12 or OHM or evidence to show that the tax has been paid or
13 collected. The application shall be signed and verified by oath
14 or affirmation by the applicant if a natural person; in the case
15 of an association or partnership, by a member or a partner; and
16 in the case of a corporation, by an executive officer or person
17 specifically authorized by the corporation to sign the
18 application.

19 (g) Registration without certificate of title prohibited.--
20 Except as provided in subsection (b), the department shall not
21 issue a registration certificate or limited registration
22 certificate for a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM or a vintage
23 snowmobile permit for a vintage snowmobile unless a certificate
24 of title has been issued by the department to the owner or an
25 application for a certificate of title has been delivered by the
26 owner to the department.

27 (h) Refusing issuance of certificate of title.--The
28 department may refuse issuance of a certificate of title if it
29 has reasonable grounds to believe any one of the following:

30 * * *

1 (2) Any taxes payable under the laws of this
2 Commonwealth on or in connection with, or resulting from the
3 acquisition or use of, the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM have
4 not been paid.

5 (3) The applicant is not the owner of the snowmobile
6 [or], ATV or OHM.

7 * * *

8 (j) Transfer of ownership of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.--

9 (1) Upon the sale or transfer of ownership of a
10 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM within this Commonwealth, the
11 owner shall execute an assignment and warranty of title to
12 the transferee in the space provided on the certificate of
13 title or as the department prescribes, sworn to before a
14 notary public or other officer empowered to administer oaths,
15 and deliver the certificate to the transferee at the time of
16 the delivery of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

17 (2) Except as otherwise provided in section 7715.1
18 (relating to snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM purchased from
19 dealer), the transferee shall, within 15 days of the
20 assignment of the certificate of title, apply for a new title
21 by forwarding to the department the certificate of title
22 executed as required by paragraph (1), a properly completed
23 application for certificate of title, sworn to before a
24 notary public or other officer empowered to administer oaths,
25 and such other forms as the department may require.

26 * * *

27 § 7712.2. Transfer to or from dealer.

28 (a) Transfer to dealer.--If a dealer acquires a snowmobile
29 [or], ATV or OHM for the purpose of resale, a certificate of
30 title need not be applied for as provided for in section 7712.1

1 (relating to certificate of title for snowmobile [or], ATV or
2 OHM), but the dealer shall, within seven days from the date of
3 acquisition, forward to the department, upon a form prescribed
4 and furnished by the department, notification of the acquisition
5 of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

6 (b) Execution and display of notice of transfer.--A dealer
7 making notification pursuant to subsection (a) shall execute at
8 least three copies of the notification, the original of which
9 shall be forwarded to the department, one copy to accompany the
10 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM in any subsequent transfer and one
11 copy to be retained by the dealer for at least one year after a
12 subsequent transfer, to be exhibited, with the assigned
13 certificate of title, upon request of a police officer or
14 authorized department employee.

15 (c) Transfer from dealer.--Except as otherwise provided in
16 subsection (a), if a dealer transfers the dealer's interest in a
17 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM:

18 * * *

19 (d) Exception for repossessed snowmobiles [or], ATV's or
20 OHM's.--This section does not apply to a snowmobile [or], ATV or
21 OHM repossessed upon default of performance of a lease, contract
22 of conditional sale or similar agreement.

23 * * *

24 § 7712.3. Transfer of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM by operation
25 of law.

26 (a) General rule.--If the interest of an owner in a
27 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM passes to another other than by
28 voluntary transfer, the transferee shall, except as otherwise
29 provided, promptly mail or deliver to the department the last
30 certificate of title, if available, and shall apply for a new

1 certificate of title on a form prescribed and furnished by the
2 department. The application shall be accompanied by such
3 instruments or documents of authority, or certified copies
4 thereof, as may be sufficient or required by law to evidence or
5 effect a transfer of title or interest in or to chattels in such
6 case.

7 * * *

8 (c) Surrender of certificate.--A person holding a
9 certificate of title, whose interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV
10 or OHM has been extinguished or transferred other than by
11 voluntary transfer, shall immediately surrender the certificate
12 of title to the person to whom the right to possession of the
13 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has passed. Upon request of the
14 department, such person shall mail or deliver the certificate to
15 the department. Delivery of the certificate pursuant to the
16 request of the department does not affect the rights of the
17 person surrendering the certificate.

18 § 7712.5. Issuance of new certificate following transfer.

19 * * *

20 (c) Filing and retention of surrendered certificate.--The
21 department shall file and retain for five years a surrendered
22 certificate of title, or a copy, in such a manner as to permit
23 the tracing of title of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

24 § 7712.6. Suspension and cancellation of certificate of title.

25 (a) Return of new snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.--The
26 department may cancel the certificate of title issued for a new
27 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM if it is shown by satisfactory
28 evidence that the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has been returned
29 to the dealer from whom obtained.

30 (b) Snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM sold to nonresidents.--The

1 department may cancel a certificate of title for a snowmobile
2 [or], ATV or OHM sold to a resident of another state or foreign
3 country if the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is to be registered
4 in the other jurisdiction.

5 * * *

6 § 7712.7. Application for certificate of title by agent.

7 (a) Authorization to apply.--No person may apply for a
8 certificate of title on behalf of another person unless
9 authorization to do so is in effect and is verified by oath or
10 affirmation of the other person, made, except as between lessors
11 and fleet owners as lessees, not more than 15 days before the
12 application is received by the department. A lessor may
13 authorize a fleet owner to apply for a certificate of title for
14 a leased snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for a period of up to one
15 year.

16 * * *

17 (c) Persons authorized to hold certificate.--No person may
18 receive, obtain or hold a certificate of title recorded in the
19 name of another person for the other person who is not in the
20 regular employ of, or not a member of the family of, the other
21 person, unless the person receiving, obtaining or holding the
22 certificate of title has a valid undischarged security interest
23 recorded in the department against the snowmobile [or], ATV or
24 OHM represented by the certificate of title.

25 * * *

26 § 7712.8. Perfection of security interest in a snowmobile [or],
27 ATV or OHM.

28 (a) Applicability of section.--Except as otherwise provided
29 in 13 Pa.C.S. §§ 9311(d) (relating to perfection of security
30 interests in property subject to certain statutes, regulations

1 and treaties), 9315(c) and (d) (relating to secured party's
2 rights on disposition of collateral and in proceeds) and 9316(d)
3 and (e) (relating to effect of change in governing law), this
4 section provides the exclusive method of perfecting a security
5 interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a
6 certificate of title is required under this subchapter.

7 (b) Snowmobiles [or], ATV's or OHM's without Pennsylvania
8 certificate of title.--If an owner creates a security interest
9 in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a certificate of
10 title has not been issued by the department, the owner shall, at
11 the request of the secured party, promptly execute an
12 application for a certificate of title on a form prescribed by
13 the department showing the name and address of the secured
14 party. The owner shall tender the application, the existing
15 certificate of title, if any, and the required fee to the
16 department. A security interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM
17 is perfected at the time that such application, existing
18 certificate of title, if any, and required fee are received by
19 the department.

20 (c) Snowmobiles [or], ATV's or OHM's with Pennsylvania
21 certificate of title.--If an owner creates a security interest
22 in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a certificate of

3 (a) Satisfaction of secured obligation.--Unless otherwise
4 agreed by the owner, within 15 days of the satisfaction of the
5 obligation secured by a security interest in a snowmobile [or],

7 certificate of title to the owner or to the department with a
8 statement of satisfaction signed by the secured party. Upon
9 receipt of the certificate of title and statement of

27 (a) Crossing street or highway.--No person under 16 years of
28 age shall drive a snowmobile [or], an ATV or an OHM across any
29 highway or connecting street thereto unless he is under the
30 direct supervision of a person 18 years of age or older and

1 unless he holds a valid and appropriate safety certificate from
2 the Commonwealth or a valid and approved certificate issued
3 under the authority of another state or Province of Canada. The
4 department shall determine what certificates will be approved.

6 (b.1) ATV size restrictions.--No person shall operate an ATV
7 bearing a certification label conforming to ANSI/SVIA 1 - 2010,

20 as authorized in subsections (b), (b.2) and (c).

21 (f) Certification of [snowmobile] safety instructors.--The
22 department may certify [snowmobile or ATV] safety instructors to

9 (5) Without a securely fastened helmet on the head of an

10 the department. If the operator is physically incapable of
11 making the report and there is another participant in the
12 accident not so incapacitated, the participant shall make the
13 report within the prescribed period of time after the accident.
14 In the event that there is no other participant and the operator
15 is other than the owner, then the owner shall within the
16 prescribed period of time, after learning of the facts of such
17 accident, report the matter to the department, together with
18 such information as may have come to his knowledge relating to
19 such accident. Every operator or owner of a snowmobile [or], an
20 ATV or an OHM in an accident, or surviving participant of any
21 such accident, shall make such other and additional reports as
22 the department shall require.

23 (c) Report by law enforcement officer.--A law enforcement
24 officer who investigates or receives information of an accident
25 involving a snowmobile [or], an ATV or an OHM shall make a
26 written report of the investigation or information received, and
27 such additional facts relating to the accident as may come to

4 (a) General rule.--Negligence in the use or operation of a

8 for death or injury to person or damage to property resulting
9 from negligence in the use or operation of such snowmobile [or],
10 ATV or OHM by any person using or operating the snowmobile [or],

14 § 7730. Liability insurance.

15 (a) Requirement.--A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which

19 Commonwealth. This subsection does not apply to limited
20 registrations.

21 (b) Proof of insurance.--Proof of insurance as required by
22 this section shall be produced and displayed by the owner or

24 any magistrate or any person having authority to enforce the
25 provisions of this chapter or to any person who has suffered or
26 claims to have suffered either personal injury or property

30 within 72 hours of receiving notice of such violation, injury or

1 damage or the claim of such injury or damage.

11 § 7741. Head lamps and tail lamps.

12 (a) Time of operation.--Every snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM
13 operated during hours of darkness shall display a lighted head
14 lamp and tail lamp. The lights shall be in operation during the
15 period of from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour
16 before sunrise and at any time when, due to insufficient light
17 or unfavorable atmospheric conditions caused by fog or
18 otherwise, other persons, vehicles and other objects are not
19 clearly discernible for a distance of 500 feet ahead.

20 (b) Head lamp requirements.--The head lamp shall display
21 white light of sufficient illuminating power to reveal any
22 person, vehicle or substantial object at a distance of 100 feet
23 ahead.

24 (1) If the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is equipped with
25 a multiple beam head lamp, the upper beam shall meet the
26 minimum requirements set forth in this section and the
27 lowermost beam shall be so aimed and of sufficient intensity
28 to reveal persons and vehicles at a distance of at least 50
29 feet ahead.

30 (2) If the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is equipped with

1 a single beam head lamp, the lamp shall be so aimed that when
2 the vehicle is loaded none of the high intensity portion of
3 the light, at a distance of 75 feet ahead, projects higher
4 than the level of the center of the lamp from which it comes.

6 (d) Construction.--Nothing in this section shall be
7 construed to require that an OHM be equipped with head lamps or
8 tail lamps as a requirement of sale.

11 § 7742. Brakes.

13 (b) ATV's and OHM's.--It is unlawful to operate an ATV or an
14 OHM which is not equipped with a braking system which may be
15 operated by hand or foot, capable of producing deceleration of
16 14 feet per second on level ground at a speed of 20 miles per
17 hour, and the design must permit simple and easy adjustment to
18 compensate for wear.

19 § 7743. Mufflers and sound control.

20 (a) General rule.--It is unlawful to operate a snowmobile
21 [or], an ATV or an OHM which is not equipped at all times with a
22 muffler in good working order which blends the exhaust sound
23 into the overall snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM sound and is in
24 constant operation to prevent excessive or unusual [noise]
25 sound. The exhaust system shall not emit or produce a sharp
26 popping or crackling sound. The sound intensity produced by a
27 snowmobile shall not exceed 82dbA when measured in accordance
28 with SAE Recommended Practice J 192 Exterior Sound Level for
29 Snowmobiles, as amended. The department may by regulation adopt
30 more stringent [noise] sound requirements for snowmobiles. The

1 department shall by regulation adopt [noise] sound requirements
2 for in-use operation of ATV's and OHM's using measurement
3 procedures in accordance with [ANSI/SAE] SAE Recommended
4 Practice J 1287 July 1998, Measurement of Exhaust Level of
5 Stationary Motorcycles. The sound level intensity produced by an
6 ATV or an OHM manufactured before January 1, 1998, shall not
7 exceed 99dbA, or decibels, when measured at 20 inches. The sound
8 level intensity produced by an ATV or an OHM manufactured on or
9 after January 1, 1998, shall not exceed 96dbA, or decibels, when
10 measured at 20 inches.

11 (b) Modified mufflers prohibited.--It is unlawful to modify
12 a muffler or to operate a snowmobile [or], an ATV or an OHM with
13 a modified muffler so as to increase the sound level of the
14 snowmobile or ATV above the level allowed by this section.

16 § 7751. Enforcement personnel and procedures.

17 * * *

18 (b) Forms and procedures.--The department may prescribe the
